Brief Summary of Work for this Position

The School of Nursing (SON), within the College of Health and Human Services (CHHS) at the University of North Carolina Wilmington (UNCW) invites applications for a full-time, clinical practice track faculty in Clinical Research at the rank of Clinical

Instructor/Assistant/Associate/Professor. Appointment to rank is dependent on qualifications relative to the university, college, and school standards. Practice track faculty are initially hired on a contract of up to 5 years that is renewable based on performance. Practice track faculty are eligible for promotion to higher practice track ranks.

The primary teaching responsibilities will be assigned across undergraduate and graduate Clinical Research programs to meet the needs of the SON. In addition, clinical practice track faculty have expectations related to advising students, research and scholarship, performing professional and community service and outreach, and contributing to ongoing program evaluation and improvement depending on their rank.

The successful candidate will be expected to relocate to North Carolina and maintain a campus presence as part of the School of Nursing faculty.

This position will begin August 15, 2022.

 Master's degree in a life science or health care related field with relevant biopharmaceutical, clinical research, or health care experience

Candidates must have experience working on product development, clinical studies, or regulatory approval of medical therapies.
