### Brief Summary of Work for this Position

The Clinical Research program, part of the School of Nursing (SON), within the College of Health and Human Services (CHHS) at the University of North Carolina Wilmington (UNCW) invites applications for a **Full-time, Clinical Track Faculty in Clinical Research** position at the rank of Clinical Instructor/Clinical Assistant/Clinical Associate/Clinical Professor. The Clinical Research program is a non-nursing degree program based in the School of Nursing. Please note, this position does not involve teaching students seeking a nursing degree.

Appointment to rank is dependent on qualifications relative to the university, college, and school standards. Clinical track faculty are initially hired on a contract of up to 5 years that is renewable based on performance. Clinical track faculty are eligible for promotion to higher clinical track ranks.

The primary teaching responsibilities will be assigned across undergraduate and graduate Clinical Research (non-nursing) programs. In addition, clinical track faculty have expectations related to advising students, scholarship, performing professional and community service and outreach, and contributing to ongoing program evaluation and improvement depending on their rank.

The successful candidate will be expected to relocate to North Carolina and maintain a campus presence as part of the School of Nursing faculty.

This position will begin August 15, 2022.

### Minimum Education and Experience Requirements

#### For the rank of Clinical Instructor

- A Master's degree in a life science, health care, clinical research, or relevant Master's degree with relevant experience in medical therapeutic product development, clinical research, or health care.

#### For the rank of Clinical Assistant/Associate/Professor

- A Doctoral degree in a life science or health care related field or other terminal degree (e.g., PhD, PharmD, DPH, EdD, DNP, MD, or JD) with relevant experience in biopharmaceutical development, clinical research, or health care.

Candidates must have experience working on biopharmaceutical product development, clinical studies, regulatory affairs, data management, safety, business development, approval of medical therapies, or other related clinical research experience.

### Preferred Education, Knowledge, Skills & Experience

Preference will be given to candidates with experience in teaching (i.e., academic or professional development) and clinical research.

### Required Certifications or Licensure

**Primary Function of Organizational Unit**

The Clinical Research Program is within the School of Nursing. In June 2004, UNC Wilmington admitted the first cohort to the Bachelor of Science in Clinical Research (non-nursing major) program. This inaugural class of five students graduated in May 2006 and enrollment has increased steadily to currently 50-60 students admitted each year. A Minor in clinical research was subsequently added to the curriculum. In January 2011, UNCW accepted students into a Master of Science in Clinical Research and Product Development program. In 2017, a Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Clinical Research Operations program was added.

Courses in the Clinical Research BS program are primarily online with the exception of the senior internship experience. Courses in the graduate programs are completely online.

The School of Nursing has an outstanding legacy of serving the people of southeastern North Carolina through education, scholarship, and service. The SON is dedicated to excellence in the development of health care professionals through in-depth education, professional partnerships, applied research, regional engagement, and community outreach and impact. Over 2,500 undergraduate and nearly 600 graduate students are enrolled in programs within the SON. Currently, the SON has 80 full-time faculty.
